 - · Scan QR for website




- You can

PARKING INFORMATION

If you plan to operate a car on campus, purchase a parking decal. Failure to register your vehicle will result in a fine. Students can register their vehicle for a parking permit online by visiting parking.ship.edu at the beginning of August. Once you have completed the online registration process, you MUST purchase your permits online using a credit card.

Students who have completed the parking pass registration can pick up their parking decals during move-in day. Students must register and pay by credit card online at parking.ship.edu before arriving at this location. Student must show their SU ID to pick up their parking pass.
