STAFF SUPPORT ROLES

Residence Directors (RD)

- One assigned to each hall
- Graduate student with experience in Housing & Residence Life
- Provides building supervision, community support, and student outreach

Resident Assistants (RA)

- 6-9 RAs per building, supervised by the RD
- Undergraduate student with experience living on campus
- Trained in peer-to-peer mediation and community leadership

Residence Hall Staff can assist students with questions, facilities issues, roommate problems, academic concerns, finding resources on campus, emergencies, etc.

Mail and Packages

HOUSING POLICIES

Housing Agreement

- Legally binding agreement for full academic year
- Two-year residency requirement

Room Changes

- Room freeze until Monday, September 9
- Students can change rooms after speaking with their RD and finding another room and/or roommate.
- No swapping keys or moving without permission.

Housing Selection

- Students will be notified of housing for next year in the fall.
- Room selection will be in early spring semester.

COMMUNICATION
