

- On-Call






# **UCC LOCATION & HOURS**

# THE FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

"The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records."

"The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education."

#### **RIGHTS OF STUDENTS**

- The right to inspect and review their educational records
- The right to request an amendment of an educational record the student believes is inaccurate
- The right to consent to disclosure of information contained in their educational records
- The right to file a complaint with the Family Policy Compliance Office (FPCO) if they feel there has been a failure to comply

#### **Financial Aid**

- If listed on Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), no need for release
- If not listed on FAFSA, release signed by student is required
- If form is needed, email FA at finaid@ship.edu to request the form

#### **Student Accounts**

• Students may set up individuals as an authorized users via TouchNet

#### Registrar's Office

# UNIVERSITY POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Public Safety is responsible for providing a safe living, learning and working environment for the campus community.
- 15 Pa Act 120 Certified Sworn Police Officers
- Patrol Campus 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
- SUPD Contact Information (717) 477-1444
- Patrol, Parking Enforcement, Motor Vehicle Enforcement, Criminal Arrests, Service Calls, Vehicle Assistance, Welfare Checks





#### SAFETY ON CAMPUS

- All residence hall doors are locked 24 hours a day. Electronic
  alarms warn the staff of unlocked or open exit doors in the residence
  halls. A card access system permits only students and authorized
  personnel to enter the hall with an I.D. card through the front
  entrance. Visitors must sign in at the main desk.
- Emergency call boxes are available throughout campus and students can request a ride or police assistance traveling across campus at night.
- Ship maintains a mass **emergency notification system** that provides timely safety information to the entire campus.
- If students have a safety concerns, they are encouraged to reach out to the Department of Public Safety.

#### REGISTERING FOR A PARKING PERMIT

- \$75.00 for first permit
- \$10.00 for each additional permit
- Register all vehicle and personal information online
- Credit card payment online ONLY

#### WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW

- Our community standards are the set of expectations that SU has for all students, and that all students agree to follow by enrolling at Ship. They are based on three core principles: Integrity, Responsibility, & Respect.
- These standards are found in the Student Code of Conduct and the student handbook called the *The Swataney* (Swah-taw-nee), both are found online.
- The Student Code of Conduct process views students as adults, is rooted in education & growth, and it is a confidential process (FERPA)
- We are often notified of incidents that happen off-campus and the Student Code of Conduct applies to students no matter where they are.
   Students are expected to represent our core principles whether they are on or off campus.



#### **ALCOHOL & OTHER DRUGS**

- Alcohol, cannabis, and other non-prescription drugs & controlled substances, are not permitted on the Shippensburg University campus.
- Parental notification for those under age 21 if a student is found responsible.
- Students should understand that an arrest off campus for violations
   —such as underage drinking, driving under the influence, or
   disorderly conduct can result in a student going through the
   student conduct process in addition to the court system.

- Cyberstalking and cyberbullying can quickly become harassment and can be pursued through the criminal court system and/or the student conduct process.














# DECISION MAKING (AND HOW YOU CAN HELP!)

- Don't hesitate to let us know





Title IX is a federal civil rights law passed as part of the Education Amendments of 1972. The law protects people from discrimination on the basis of gender in education programs or activities that receive federal financial assistance. Title IX protects much more then gender.







# **WHAT IS REQUIRED?**

#### •MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella)

- 2 doses
- Given 28 days apart after age 12 months

#### •TdaP (Tetanus, Diptheria and Pertussis)

1 dose within the last 10 years

#### Varicella (Chicken Pox)

2 doses, or 1 dose and documented disease

#### Meningitis (on-campus housing)

 Sign off on the Ship portal if over 18, mail to Etter Health Center is under 18





## OTHER "HOUSEKEEPING" ITEMS



#### · Insurance Information

- Etter Health Center does not currently bill insurance for services provided at the health center.
- Lab work, x-rays or referrals to an outside facility will be billed to insurance.

#### Release of Information

 If your student would like us to discuss any medical information with anyone (including you) this form will need to be completed.




